





Last but not the least, I would like to conclude my message by saying that no one can go back and make a brand new start but anyone can start from now and make a brand new ending.





Cognitive biases and the limitations of human brain.



The 'thinking mind' is the part of the brain that seeks to make sense of our surroundings; it analyses situations, evaluates solutions, creates scenarios, tells stories and makes decisions. It is an inherent aspect of what makes us human. But, various cognitive bottlenecks limit its ability to process multiple information and its capacity to consider multiple parameters while making decisions.

Intrinsic limitations of the thinking mind.

The human senses have various limitations. Our limited sensory capabilities mean that there are many sources of information we cannot perceive at all. For example, bees can see infrared, which is invisible to the human eye. For the most part, we are naturally aware of these sensory limitations. But, somehow, we tend to overestimate our cognitive capacities — our ability to concurrently process multiple streams of information or to work on several tasks at the same time.

So we multitask; we believe that by combining two tasks, we will complete them sooner than if we worked on them separately. We also trust that we can consider many different facts when making complex decisions. But our thinking mind is limited by two Bottlenecks: our attention and our working memory. Simply put, we're bad at dividing our attention between different tasks.

Everyone will have different profiles for levels of attention and working memory, and your cognitive capacities also vary throughout the day and throughout the years. Being aware of the existence of these cognitive bottlenecks can help to make more sound decisions in our daily life. 




